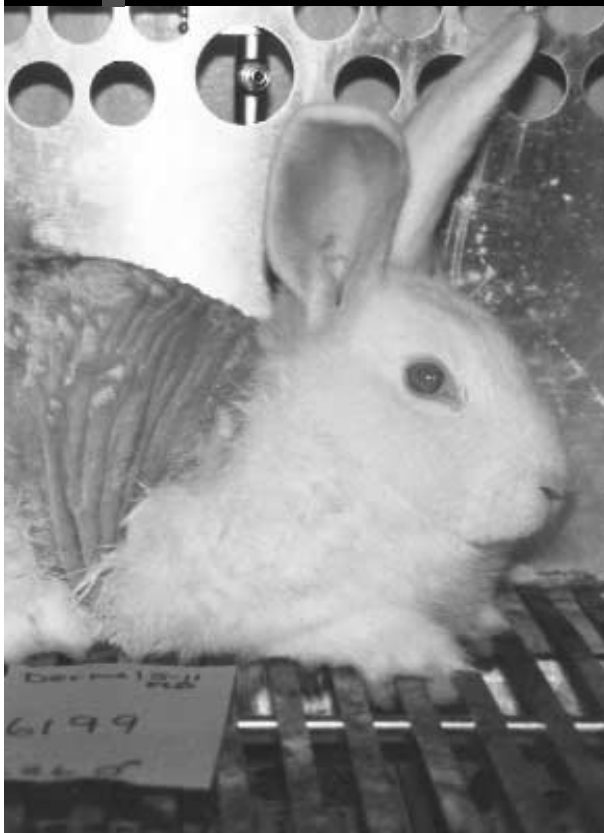




# CRUEL DOT Animal Tests
